WHAT IS THE PROBLEM?

- EU funds have an obligation to comply with legal requirements.
- Yet, in many countries, marginalised groups such as Roma, people with disabilities or migrants face segregated education or housing.
- Sometimes this is funded by EU money, which is a clear violation of their fundamental rights.
- NGOs in six countries have now joined forces to fight against discrimination.

WHAT ARE WE DOING?

- We built a European coalition of non-governmental organisations (NGOs) and experts.
- We're on a mission to collect cases of discrimination in EU funds, as enshrined in the EU Charter of Fundamental Rights.
- We will launch advocacy and legal actions to fight against injustice.
- We will raise awareness in the media to ensure no one turns a blind eye.
